Hotel History

Welcome to Century Old Town
Prague - MGallery Collection.

The hotel building was constructed in an eclectic style in 1894.

Its architector, Alfons Wertmüller, was also involved in the design of several important buildings in Prague e.g. the Prague State Opera House. Originally the building served as Workers' Accident Insurance Company for the Kingdom of Bohemia.

In 2002 it was turned into a hotel and was renovated by French interior designer Ana Moussinet. Much of the new features were inspired by the 19th-century Cubism art movement, as well as Art Deco style.

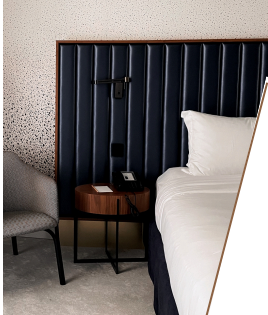

Old Town Square

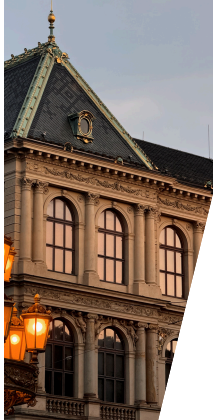

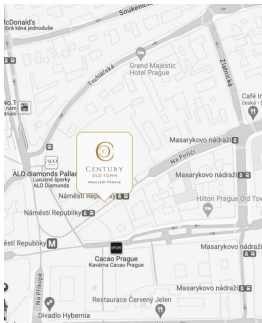
Charles Bridge

A must-see, the Charles Bridge is just a short walk from the hotel, offering a picturesque stroll over the Vltava River. It is lined with statues of saints and connects the Old Town with the Lesser Town (Malá Strana), providing stunning views of the city and Prague Castle.

Prague Castle

Located a bit further uphill, Prague Castle is the largest ancient castle in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage site. The castle complex includes the St. Vitus Cathedral, Golden Lane, and offers breathtaking views of the city.
