



THE WESTIN

HAMBURG

Location

The Westin Hamburg is located directly in the Elbphilharmonie, the special architectural and cultural landmark of the city of Hamburg, a building complex with an imposing glass facade on the western tip of the Hafencity quarter. It is also home to the auditoriums of the Elbphilharmonie concert hall.

Architecture

On the existing structural shell of the brick Kaispeicher A, a former warehouse for cocoa, tobacco and tea, the architects Herzog & de Meuron have placed a curved glass facade consisting of over 1,000 window elements. These have a variety of curves, resulting in some unique reflective effects. Their shapes recall huge horseshoes and tuning forks. The concave roof with shimmering spangles finishes off the 110-metre high structure with shapes like the crest of a wave. The Westin Hamburg covers the eastern section of the building, from the 6th floor to the top floor, 20 storeys high. Here, hotel guests can experience the symbiosis of water, glass and stone as well as port and city like nowhere else.

General Manager

Madeleine Marx is the new General Manager of The Westin Hamburg. She began her hotel career in the „Fairmont Hotel Vier Jahreszeiten“ in Hamburg and has gained international experiences in London, Paris and Boston ever since. After a few stations at the Marriott group, Mrs. Marx took over the leadership position of The Westin Hamburg mid-September 2018.

Interior Design

Tassilo Bost, bost group berlin, is responsible for the design concept of the rooms. The calm, purist design with its themes of sand, air and water combines straight lines with a flowing design idiom. As for BLICK the modern architecture of the Elbphilharmonie and its maritime setting are taken up with natural textures and a colour palette ranging from pale blue and petrol green to sandy and earthy tones in responsibility of the sought-after London architecture duo Muza Lab.



Rooms & Suites

244 rooms and suites on floors 9 to 20, with a minimum height above the Elbe river of 40 meters. All rooms are furnished with a Heavenly Bed, which ensures particularly restful sleep and a high degree of comfort. The rooms and suites are divided into the following categories:

- 35 Classic Elbphilharmonie Rooms, 35 m² in size with a view to the atrium.
- 90 Deluxe Hafencity Rooms, 31 m² in size with a view over the Hafencity and the city itself.
- 37 Premium City Panorama Rooms, 38 m² in size with a view over the Hafencity and the city itself.
- 43 Premium Waterkant Panorama Rooms, 35 m² in size with a view over the Elbe river and the industrial port.
- 15 Elbphilharmonie Studios, 45 m² in size with a view over the Elbe river or the Hafencity.
- 12 Elbphilharmonie Suites, 61 m² in size, every suite is unique in its design.
- 4 Maisonette Suites, 103 m² in size over two floors and with a view over the city or the port.
- 7 Horizon Suites, 92 m² in size with a panoramic view over the city, Hafencity or port.
- The Owner's Suite on the 19th floor, covering 162 m² with a 270-degree view over the port and city of Hamburg.

Restaurant Fang & Feld

The restaurant on the 7th floor has capacity for 170 guests and offers a "hanseatic bistronomy" concept in a relaxed atmosphere. Chef Sebastian Michels prepares the "Best Of" meat and fish, like fried cod fillet with North German sniff and crispy bacon or Tatar of the Willow Ox with egg, toasted bread, caper apple and roasted onion oil.

BLICK

BLICK forms a bridge between the classics at the Elbphilharmonie and the vibrant atmosphere of the Hafencity. Fusion of day and night: with its culinary delights and the interplay of harbourside flair with the casual elegance of the globally renowned concert hall, the plaza level is the beating heart of the hotel, from sunrise to sunset. BLICK ensures that every guest can find their new favourite place to while away, regardless of the occasion or time of day.

Health & Wellness

The Westin Hamburg Spa has an area of 1,300 m², treatment rooms for individuals and couples, one of the longest indoor swimming pools in Hamburg, saunas, steam baths, two open-air loggias with a view over the Elbe river and port, lounge, relaxation room and the Westin WORKOUT fitness area. It is also open to external visitors as a day spa and is located on the 6th floor. There is also a choice of different memberships. One of the highlights is our private suite which implies a bottle of champagne and fresh fruits.

Club Lounge

All Platinum Bonvoy members and guests staying at our suites have exclusive access to the Westin Club Lounge on the 19th floor with a view to the atrium.

Westin Meetings

Nine meeting and event rooms for up to 230 people cover nearly 630 m² – including a 260 m² foyer.

- **BLICKfang**

The VIP lounge is a special location for exclusive events in a unique scenario with a view over the Hafencity and the city center. The lounge offers space for up to 26 people.

- **Sky High Meetings**

With 162 m² the Owner's Suite is the perfect place for tactful decisions, interviews, negotiations and trainings. Located on the 19th floor with a structured room layout, a meeting point for six people, a small kitchen, a living area and a balcony, the view automatically wanders towards Hafencity and the Elbe river.
