




CLASSICAL - QUIRKY - CHARMING

It's a place where service is understated and warm - we remain true to our name.






A CURIOUS HISTORY

The city council bought the building in 1522 and turned it into a prison. The Spanish rulers mistook its Flemish name *vrunt* to mean *vriend*, or *amigo*. The locals seemed to have enjoyed the irony, because the name stuck.

It became a hotel in 1957, just in time to host royals, celebrities and VIPs for the Brussels World's Fair.



that have coloured this northern European city.






MEETINGS AND EVENTS
