Scandic Holmenkollen Park is perched high above the city like a palace out of a Norwegian fairytale, it offers stunning views over the city and the surrounding landscape. A unique conference venue, and just a 15 minutes drive from Oslo city centre.

The oldest part of the hotel dates from 1894 and is timber-built in the «dragon» style of the medieval Norwegian «stave» churches.

Here you will find our first class restaurant «De Fem Stuer», as well as comfortable lounges and a range of banqueting and conference rooms, all named after famous Norwegians. Our well-equipped conference hall hosts up to 800 delegates, and the hotel also offers modern SPA facilities, a well equipped gym and an indoor swimming pool.

Located close to the Holmenkollen Ski Stadium and Ski Museum and with direct access to wonderful skiing, walking and cycling country, the hotel offers superb opportunities for recreation and relaxation in the heart of nature, yet close to the city.

Superior

Large, classic rooms with TV and wireless internet. Most superior rooms have a view.

Standard

Rooms with TV and wireless internet. Some rooms have two 90 cm beds, others one 160 cm bed. Standard rooms do not have a view.

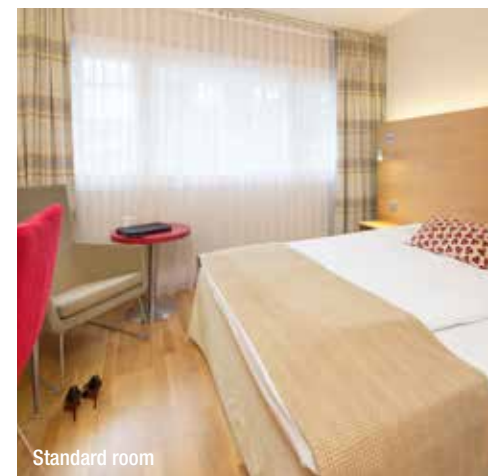
All rooms come with clean fresh air, comfy beds and crisp linen.

FROM THE SIMPLE TO THE NAIL-BITING

At Scandic Holmenkollen Park you will find activities no other hotel in Oslo can offer: Four pole-pushes, a 90-metre ski jump and a Super-G. Next to the hotel lies the Holmenkollen Ski Jump, the Ski Museum and the beautiful Holmenkollen Chapel. Here you will find some of Oslo's biggest tourist attractions, and a wealth of opportunities.

The ski jump is the jewel in the Holmenkollen sports arena's crown. More than a century old, it has been rebuilt 14 times, and is today a modern facility with a fantastic view – rising 417 metres above sea level! We offer activities of every sort, from the simple to the nail-biting. Abseil from the top of the ski jump, try your hand at the biathlon (skiing and shooting combined) or snowball throwing, enjoy a barbecue or dinner. Why not stage your own mini-Olympics (summer or winter), featuring events of your choice, for your colleagues or business associates?

The Ski Museum opened in 1923 and is the world's oldest. Exhibits include equipment from Fridtjof Nansen and Roald Amundsen's polar expeditions. The museum is the perfect place to start an evening event, with before-dinner aperitifs, followed by a recital in the Holmenkollen Chapel – with a torchlit stroll between the hotel and the chapel. This, of course, is just one of a host of alternatives.

FROM SANATORIUM TO LUXURY HOTEL!

Scandic Holmenkollen Park was built originally as a sanatorium for tuberculosis patients. Completed in 1894, it was designed by the architect Baltazar Lange in the then hugely popular «dragon style» at the behest of Doctor I.C. Holm, a Norwegian surgeon.



When the Holmenkollen Turisthotell burned down in 1914 its operations were transferred to Dr Holm's beautiful place of rest and recreation, which was renamed Holmenkollen Turisthotell og Sanatorium. Today it is a modern conference hotel, located in stunning surroundings 350 metres above Oslo city centre, with fabulous views of the Norwegian capital and the fjord beyond.

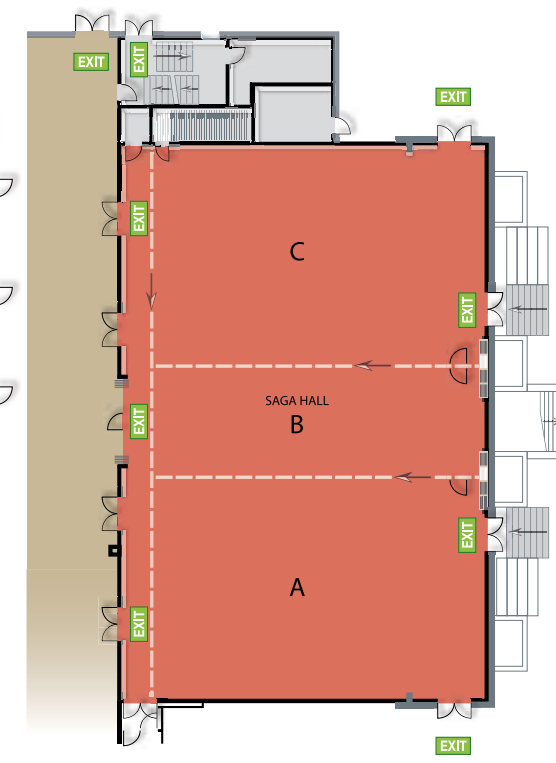
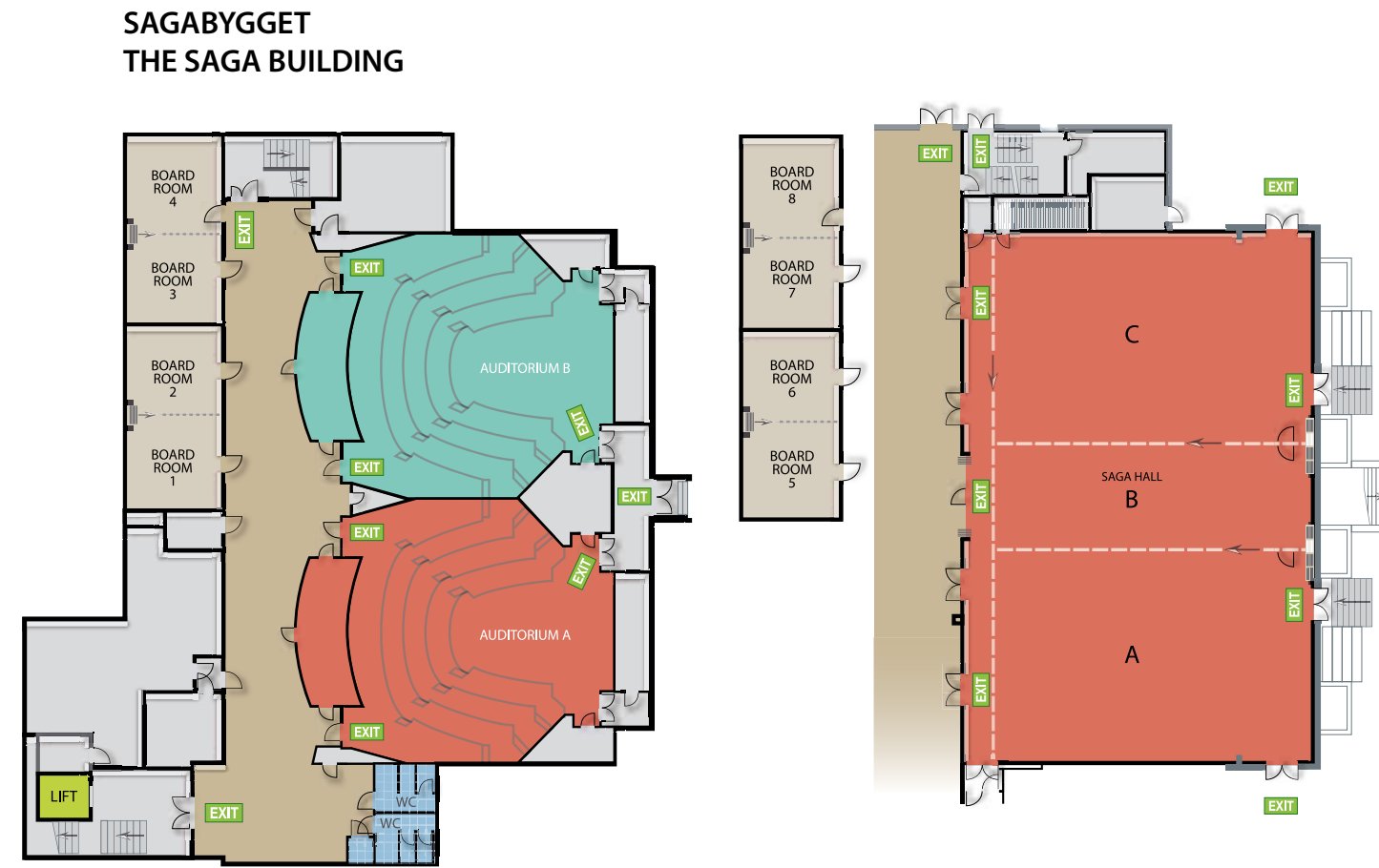
The hotel has been modernised and extended several times. First in 1948 following its occupation by the Germans during the second world war. Then in 1982, when four new accommodation wings were completed just in time for the Nordic World Ski Championships at Holmenkollen. In 1991 a new, modern conference centre, designed by Gabriel Finne, was added. Today the hotel has 343 rooms, including the new wing that was completed in time for the Nordic World Ski Championships in 2011. This latest addition comprises two



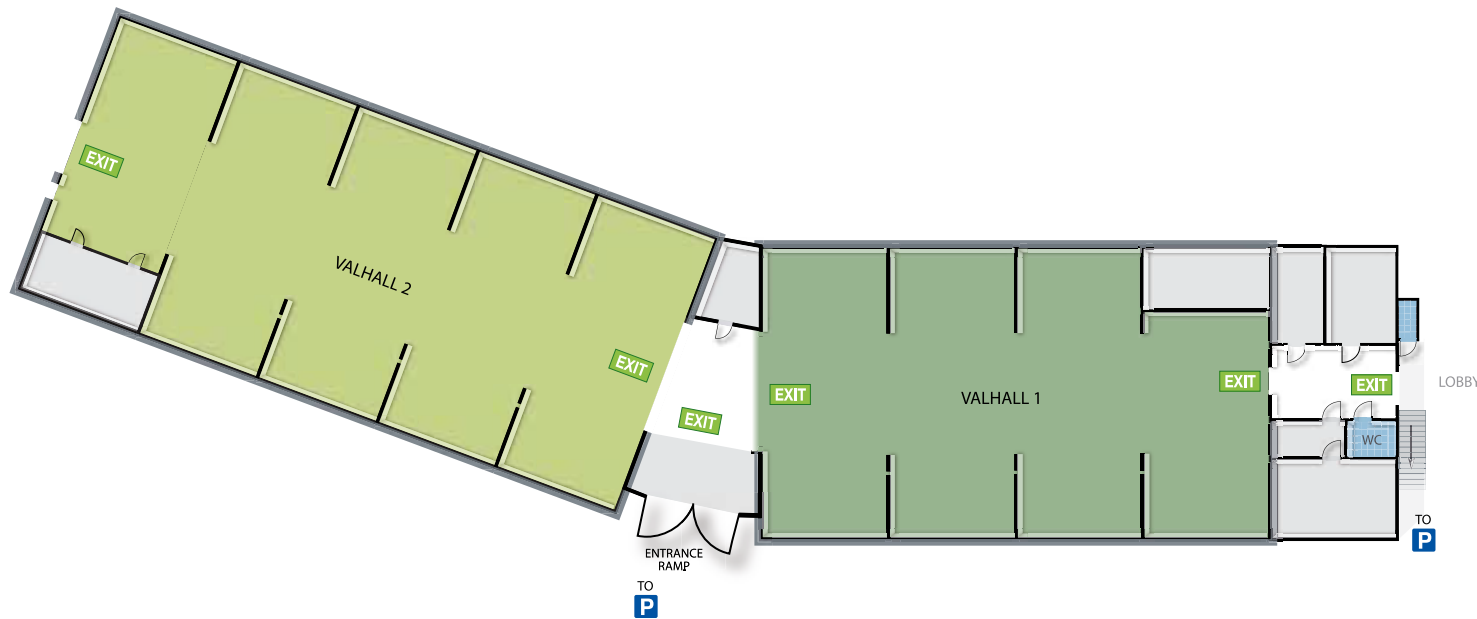
floors of suites and junior suites, all decorated with pictures of the greatest heroes of Holmenkollen's various skiing arenas and offering the hotel's most spectacular views. From here you see not only the entire hotel, but half the kingdom, too, as they say in the fairy tales!

For some things are as they always have been:

The hotel's location at Holmenkollen, sheltered from the city's hustle and bustle, rising majestically as the natural gateway to the forest's many skiing and cycle trails, as well as attractions such as the Holmenkollen Ski Jump, the Ski Museum and Holmenkollen Chapel. This combination of majestic architecture and exquisite natural beauty explains why the hotel has for many years been the preferred location when international businesses, heads of state and royalty have sought a unique setting for their events in Norway.
