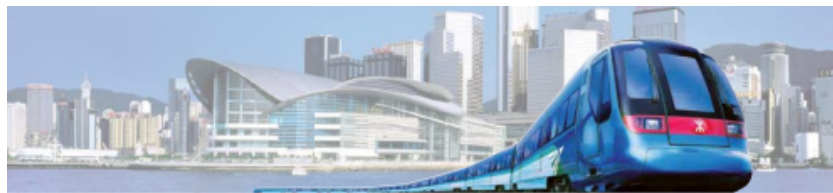
HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Kowloon Station (Hong Kong Airport Express)

The Ritz-Carlton, Hong Kong is located right above Kowloon Station and the bus terminus.



Central Station (Hong Kong MTR)

If you are transiting from the Central Station of the Hong Kong MTR, interchange from Island Line to Tung Chung Line. Take one stop to Kowloon Station and use Exit C1/D1 to get to The Ritz-Carlton, Hong Kong.

China Coach Terminus (From Shenzhen Airport to Kowloon Hong Kong/From Hong Kong to Shenzhen Airport China)

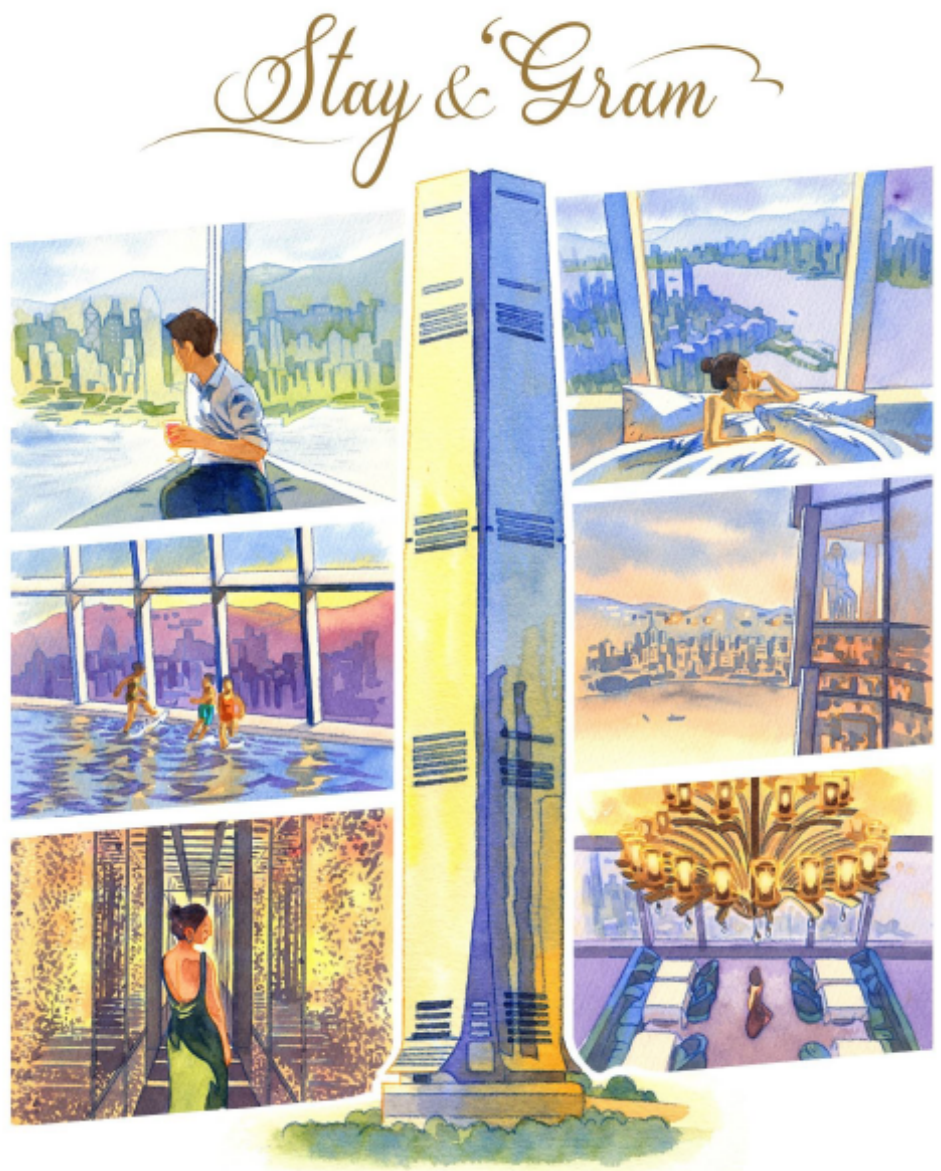
If you are traveling by China coach, the China Coach Terminus is located in the Elements Shopping Mall, which is situated at the podium level of the International Commerce Centre. The Ritz-Carlton, Hong Kong is just 5 minutes away.

High Speed Rail (Hong Kong Section)

The Ritz-Carlton, Hong Kong is 10 minutes away from High Speed Rail station (Hong Kong West Kowloon Station). High Speed Rail is the fastest cross-boundary land transport in Hong Kong that connects you from Hong Kong to 58 Mainland stations without interchange, including **Beijing, Shanghai, Harbin, Kunming, and Urumqi.**

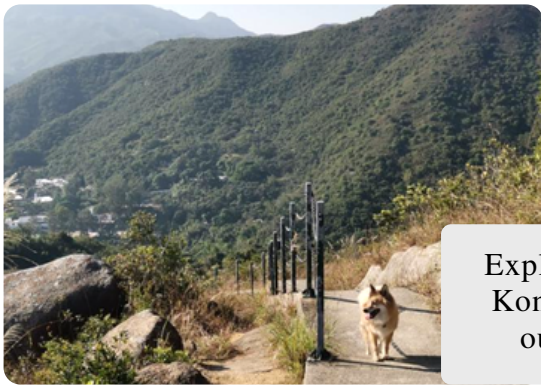

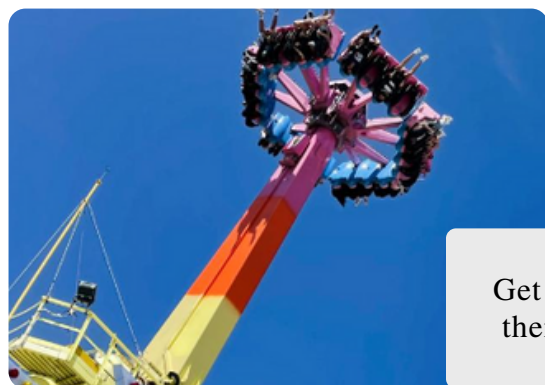

NGONG PING 360

NGONG PING CABLE CAR

Ngong Ping Cable Car connects downtown Tung Chung and Ngong Ping. During the journey you will be greeted with the vistas of the distant and vast South China Sea and the rolling greens of North Lantau Country Park as well as over the International Airport.

NGONG PING VILLAGE

As you step out of the cable car, you will be greeted by the culturally themed 1.5-hectare Ngong Ping Village, where a wide array of shops and eateries offer a delightful shopping and dining experience. And don't miss the exciting Motion 360, VR 360, and walking with Buddha multimedia presentations!

NGONG PING 360

PO LIN MONASTERY

The Po Lin Monastery is one of Hong Kong's most important Buddhist sanctums and has been dubbed 'the Buddhist World in the South'. Home to many a devout monk, this monastery is rich with colourful manifestations of Buddhist iconography and its pleasant garden is alive with birdsong and flowery scents.



TIAN TAN BUDDHA

The Big Buddha, also known as Tian Tan Buddha, is famed as the most iconic attraction of Lantau. It is the second largest outdoor bronze seated Buddha. Sitting next to the Po Lin Monastery, it is only a 10-minute walk away from Ngong Ping Village.

LANTAU ISLAND

NGONG PING / PO LIN MONASTERY / TAI O

TAI O FISHING VILLAGE

Tai O is home to the Tanka people, a community of fisher folk who've built their houses on stilts above the tidal flats of Lantau Island for generations. These unusual structures are interconnected, forming a tightly knit community that literally lives on the water.



TAI O BOAT EXCURSION

A boat excursion is probably the best way to tour around Tai O and to experience the most authentic flavours of Hong Kong's oldest fishing village. On your 20-minute boat ride, you will first go around the waterways of Tai O for a close look at villagers' everyday life in the iconic and connected stilt houses. Next, the boat will take you out to the ocean, where you can observe the "General's Rock" and Tai O Heritage Hotel (former Tai O police station). You may even get a glimpse of Chinese Pink Dolphins if you are lucky!



FURTHER EXPLORE LANTAU

SILVER MINE BAY BEACH

Silver Mine Bay Beach is probably the most convenient beach on Lantau Island, as it's within a 10-minute walk of the Mui Wo Ferry Pier. It gets busy during summertime and weekends. There are plenty of affordable Chinese restaurants at the Mui Wo Cooked Food Market, as well as local vendors close to Silver Mine Bay Beach. You can get to Lantau Island from the Central district Hong Kong by ferry, which takes about an hour.

MUI WO VILLAGE

Mui Wo Village is a rural town on the eastern coast of Lantau Island. It has lovely scenery of beaches, waterfalls and mountain ranges, along with a few historical sites such as Man Mo Temple (dating back to the 16th century) and a 19th-century watchtower.

Asia's first global museum of contemporary visual culture, features collections spanning 20th- and 21st-century visual art, design and architecture, moving image and Hong Kong visual culture. The expansive podium cantilevers above ground and includes 17,000 square meters of exhibition space across 33 galleries, three cinema houses, the Mediatheque, Learning Hub, and Roof Garden that faces Victoria Harbour. The tower stretching up from the podium contains the museum's Research Centre, offices and restaurants. The museum's prime location on the waterfront offers beautiful views of Hong Kong throughout the day.

PALACE MUSEUM

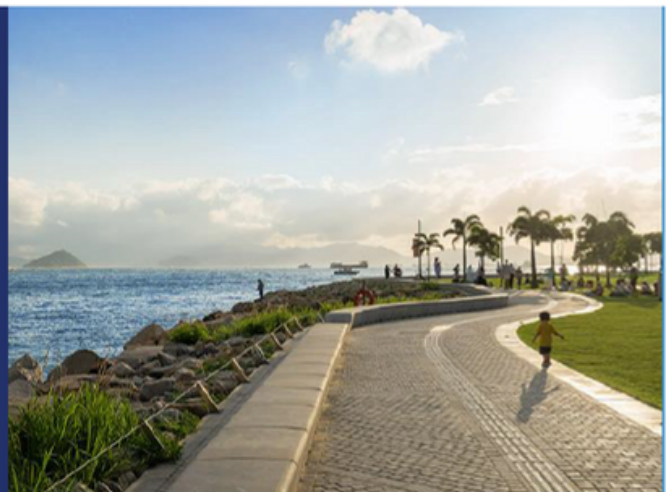
Start your exploration at Hong Kong Palace Museum, a collaborative project between the West Kowloon Cultural District Authority and the Palace Museum committed to the study and appreciation of Chinese art and culture, while advancing dialogue among world civilizations through international partnerships. The museum presents the finest objects from the Palace Museum and other important cultural institutions around the world. In addition, it will also lead community engagement programmes to promote creativity and interdisciplinary collaboration to the public.

FREESPACE

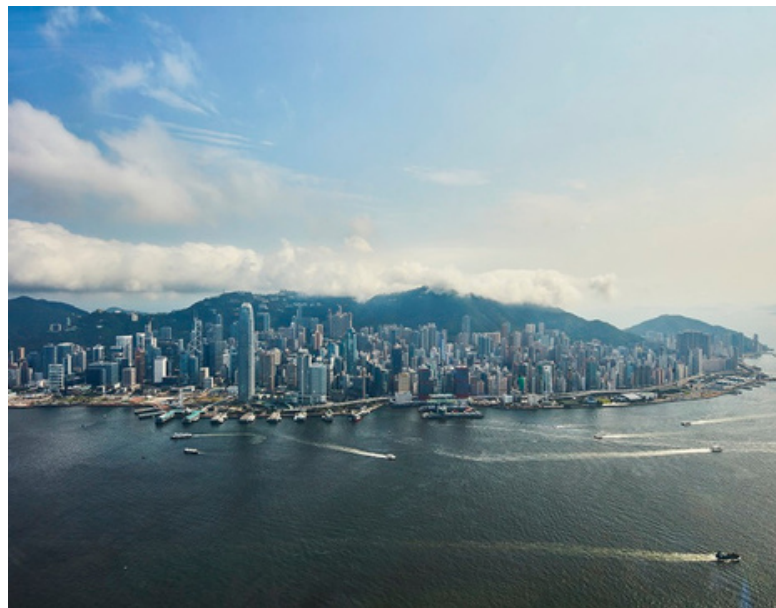
Hong Kong's centre for contemporary performance in the heart of the Art Park — presents multi-genre performances and events, and showcases emerging and established artists from Hong Kong and around the world. It also houses Hong Kong's largest black box theatre, The Box, and Lau Bak Livehouse — an intimate bar and performance space featuring regular weekend programme of live music and cultural events, and a full menu of delicious food and craft beer.

ART PARK

The Art Park offers open green spaces where visitors can relax, play or picnic on the lawns, and a long waterfront promenade perfect for sunset views of the harbour. The pet-friendly park is a vibrant venue for open-air performances, exhibitions and other cultural events, and home to occasional street performers, a gourmet food truck and multiple restaurants and cafes. You can also rent a Smart Bike to explore the pathways, or relax in the cool timber structure of the Competition Pavilion — the perfect spot for taking a break in the shade or capturing IG-worthy images.

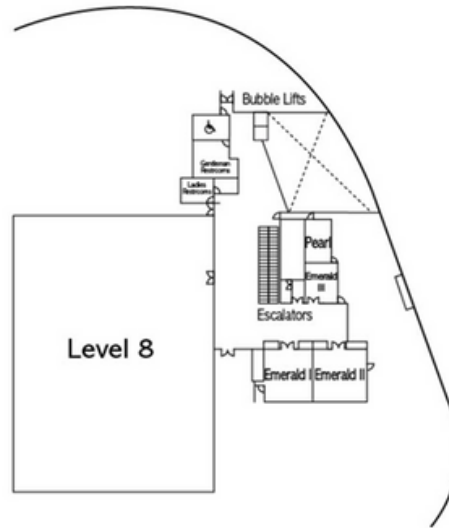
