2nd October
1910

● Grand opening of The Ritz Madrid, inspired by King Alfonso XIII's desire to build a luxury hotel to rival the Ritz in Paris and London.

1936 - 1939

● During the Spanish Civil War, the hotel became a military hospital.

2015

● Mandarin Oriental announced the acquisition of Hotel Ritz, Madrid in a joint venture with the Olayan Group.

2021

● Reopen after large scale renovation.






Rooms & Suites
