



History & charm in the heart of Edinburgh

InterContinental Edinburgh The George occupies five listed Georgian townhouses on George Street. Following a multi-million pound refurbishment to designs by Goddard Littlefair, the architectural detail of the Grade II-listed hotel is complemented by elegant interiors, from the bedrooms to the grand King's Hall, which was originally built for the Caledonian Insurance Company. The buildings date back to 1775, when Edinburgh's New Town development was at its peak, and it opened as a hotel in 1881, a conversion from three Georgian houses. The very best of Edinburgh's shopping, restaurants and nightlife are on the doorstep, including its very own Le Petit BeefBar and a specialty coffee shop called Burr & Co.
