Located in the historic center of Belém, the Palácio do Governador - Lisbon Hotel & Spa has 60 rooms, all unique, in one of the capital's cultural hubs. The building was constructed within the former home of the Governor of the Belém Tower, carefully restored over Roman ruins dating from the 1st to 5th centuries, and offers an authentic, palatial experience.

The reception is located in the old chapel, and its historic features extend over the hotel's five floors, with vaulted ceilings and original tiles dating from the 15th century. The entrance is through the courtyard, where you will find and old Roman tanks or 'cetárias' from the former 'garum' fish sauce factory. Redecorated in 2024 by acclaimed interior designer Nini Andrade da Silva, the renovated Governor's Palace has a timeless feel, where the past blends with the present and invites you to embrace the future.

The Palácio do Governador is close to the River Tagus and next door to several historical national monuments. It's the natural choice for a stay in Lisbon, close to everything from culture to leisure, but far enough away to enjoy some peace and quiet. The south-facing terraces offer views over the swimming pool, the Belém Tower and the River Tagus, creating a haven of serenity.

Honoring you.

Sitting at his dispatch desk in the half-light so as not to awaken too much to reality and time, the Governor has overseen the passing of the centuries and will do so for centuries to come. With the Belém Tower looming on the horizon, paving the way for new architectural currents at MAAT. With the pose of someone who is promptly awaiting a guest, his imposing figure stands out in a cobalt blue jacket from which the cuffs and collars protrude. A smiling face hovers above the collars. With the humility of someone who forgets the decorations weighing on his chest and a curiosity for the future and the unknown, of every second and centimeter of the world yet to be explored. It is this smile that announces what he says next, as soon as he approaches a guest: What an honor to have you in my home, which is already yours. This establishment of ours, where history is left to the future, is perfect for sharing an adventure. But first, let us have a spice-infused gin at BarTolomeu Bar, on the peace and quiet of the terrace, as I know you prefer, while they prepare chicken and kimchi gyozas that are even more succulent than in the Land of the Rising Sun.

History

Built upon old Roman ruins, as you go through the courtyard, you will see ceterariae, stone tanks from an old Roman fish sauce factory. The garum made there was exported in amphorae all over the Roman Empire. The lobby is located in the old chapel. The walls are lined with restored original tiles and you can still see the wooden quire and high ceiling. The building's genuine historical-architectural value is evident throughout: in the vaulted ceilings of the main restaurant, the successive arches of the ground floor rooms and the tiled panelling in the bedrooms and suites. The south-facing terraces offer guests and visitors a prime view overlooking the outdoor pool, the Belém Tower and the River Tagus.

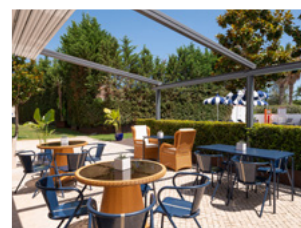
Restaurant and Bar

Belém Wellness Hub

Underneath the courtyard, the 1,200m² Belém Wellness Hub retains the Roman walls from the 1st to 5th century. It has a 25-meter heated indoor pool with dynamic jets and chromotherapy, a sauna, Turkish bath, Scottish bath, Vichy shower, 3 massage/treatment rooms and a tranquility gym. Indulge in personalized treatments, take a dip in our exquisite swimming pool or reinvigorate yourself in our 24-hour gym.
