- Use of LED lighting with photosensors for lighting control.

Energy, Carbon & Water reduction

- Energy-efficient guestroom controls and building systems.
- Onsite solar panels.
- Connection to urban central network.
- Smart metering throughout the hotel to monitor energy consumption.
- Green energy procurement.
- Energy sourced from renewable or carbon-free sources.
- Water conservation measures in place, including water-efficient landscaping.

Water Management

- Water-efficient technology capturing and storing rainwater for non-potable uses and installing greywater recycling systems to treat and reuse water from sinks, showers, and laundry facilities for non-potable purposes.
- Use of osmotic/filtered water in restaurants.
- Water-saving kitchen and laundry equipment's.
- Landscaping with native and drought tolerant plants.
- Efficient drip irrigation.
- Hotel located in a high water stressed region, as classified by the Water Risk Atlas Tool.







Waste Reduction

- Elimination of single-use plastic: water bricks with vegetable plugs, Bamboo Amenities and 95% vegetable origin, straws made of vegetable fiber material, bagasse for take-away food as well as lids.
- Room cards made of recycled wood.
- Refillable, large bathroom amenities provided in guest rooms. For sanitary reasons, the canisters must be replaced periodically.
- Polycarbonate and melamine cups for the rooftop and terraces.
- Water fountains in offices.
- Recycling program in place including recycling bins in all guestrooms and meeting space.
- Organic waste diversion program in place.
- Reduction of paper waste i.e. paperless e-billing, 100% recycled meeting room pads, QR codes..
- Amenities made of sustainable material and packaging.
- Pneumatic waste collection.
- Glass crushers and recycling enclosure.

Sustainable Food & Beverage

- Vegan and vegetarian menu items available.
- Menus feature local, seasonal and sustainably sourced ingredients from farmers, fisheries and purveyors.
- Cage-free eggs.
- Food waste reduction program.
- Endangered species banned from all menus.
